


Installing HSPA MODEM on Windows XP


1. Insert the HSPA MODEM into an available USB port on the PC, Windows will detect the new hardware automatically as a removable storage device and install the drivers.
2. *Pop-up window* will appear.




3. Click the **Next** button.



4. Read the *License Agreement* -> Click the button **I Agree** if you are agree with the given terms and conditions.



5. Click the **Browse** button -> Select the *location* that you need to install the Optus Wireless Broadband.
6. Click the **Next** button.




7. Select an existing *Start Menu Folder* OR create a *New Folder* to make a shortcut for the Optus Wireless Broadband program.
8. Click the **Install** button. This will launch the Optus Wireless Broadband application on your PC.



9. Click the **Finish** button. Then the *set up window* will disappear.
10. Go to the location that you have created the *shortcut* for the Optus Wireless Broadband program. (e.g. Desktop)




11. Double click the *Icon* to open the window.



12. Go to the *Menu bar* -> Click **Tools** -> Select **Options** from the *drop down menu*.




13. This will display the *Options* window.




14. Click **Profile Management** option. Sometimes you may see a already created profile named "Wireless BB".

15. Select this profile -> Click the **Delete** button.

16. Then click the **New** button -> Fill the fields as shown in below image.



17. Click the **Save** button.
18. The button **Set As Default** will be enabled once you save the created profile.
19. Click the **Set As Default** button -> Click the **OK** button. Then the following window will be appeared.



20. Click the **Connect** button. This will connect your PC to the Internet.
